The assignment of the teaching position will go through the following stages: • for associate professor (military) - according to the provisions of Law no. 80/1995 and of the normative acts applicable to military higher education institutions, provided that the selection stages have been completed, as stated in art. 59 of the Methodology of organizing and holding contests for teaching and research positions in "Mihai Viteazul" National Intelligence Academy; • for associate professor (civilian) - according to the provisions of Law no. 53/2003 - Labor Code, as amended and supplemented, National Education Law no. 1/2011, to the normative acts applicable to military educational institutions, provided that the selection stages have been completed, as stated in art. 59 of the Methodology of organizing and holding contests for teaching and research positions in "Mihai Viteazul" National Intelligence Academy. The general and specific conditions of registration for the competition for the position of associate professor (military/civilian) are provided in the Methodology of organizing and holding contests for teaching and research positions in "Mihai Viteazul" National Intelligence Academy. Specific activities - Managing the teaching load in accordance with article 287 from Law no. 1/2011 as amended and supplemented. - The weekly minimal teaching load - 10 conventional hours, of which at least 4 are dedicated to teaching activities. Teaching load - 40 hours/week. Filling this position requires advanced specialized knowledge, professional competences and abilities pertaining to the aforementioned vacant academic disciplines and meeting the criteria stated in article 14, paragraph 2 of the Methodology for occupying vacant teaching and research positions in "Mihai Viteazul" National Intellige

The contest committee evaluates the candidate from the perspective of the following aspects:

- a) the relevance and impact of the candidate's scientific results:
- b) the candidate's ability to guide students or young researchers;
- c) the didactic skills of the candidate related to the position;
- d) the candidate's ability to transfer his/her knowledge and results or to disseminate his/her own scientific results;
- e) the ability to work in a team and the efficiency of scientific collaborations, depending on the candidate's field;
- f) previous experiences of the candidate in higher education institutions.

The test involves the delivery of a lecture, as the case may be, in the presence of the committee. The program related to the lecture will be published on the website www.animv.ro together with the publication of the announcement regarding the competition. The commission sets the topic for the lecture 48 hours before its presentation and it is published on www.animv.ro.

The full list of documents, which the candidates must include in the exam file, is the following:

- a)Application form (Appendix 10), signed by the candidate and an affidavit regarding the validity of the information in the file;
- b)A proposal for the academic career development of the candidate from the teaching perspective (the proposal is elaborated by the candidate, has a maximum of 10 pages and is one of the main yardsticks for the candidates);
- c)A Curriculum Vitae in printed and digital format (signed by the candidate) that will include:
- -Information about studies and diplomas;
- -Information about the professional experience and relevant previous working places:
- -Information about the research projects led as project director and the grants accessed. in case there are such projects and grants, mentioning for each the source of financing, the amount of financing and the main publications as a result of these
- -Information about awards or other prizes as an acknowledgment of the scientific contributions of the candidate.
- d)A list of published papers in printed and digital format (Appendix 11), signed by the candidate, which includes:
- -max 10 papers considered the most relevant by the candidate, which are to be included digitally in the file and which can be found among the other paper categories mentioned in the present article;
- -doctoral thesis;
- -invention licence or other titles of intellectual property;
- -books or chapters in books;
- -articles, published in international scientific circuit;
- -papers published in extenso, delivered at the main international conferences;

-other papers or publications. e) A verification form attesting the compliance with the Academy's standards for participating in the contest (Appendix 1, 2, 3); f) A maximum one page abstract of the PhD paper, in Romanian and in an international language; q) An affidavit indicating the incompatibility situations as per present legal regulations in which the candidate could find himslef in case he/she passes the exam or the lack of these situations (Appendix 12); h) The following legalized documents: PhD diploma or its recognized equivalent (if applicable); BA diploma and its supplement or its recognized equivalent (if applicable); Baccalaureate diploma or its recognized equivalent (if applicable); birth certificate; marriage certificate (if applicable); documents attesting previous work experience (the General Register of work); i) Copy of the candidate's ID; j) Copies of the documents that prove the change of the name / surname (if applicable) k) Maximum 10 publications, patents or other papers, in digital format, selected by the candidate and considered to be the most relevant for his professional accomplishments; I) In order to sustain the points in the verification form, the candidate will provide copies of: covers of publication/book/paper/CD that indicate the ISSN or ISBN, as well as copies of the publication/book contents where the article /chapter ist o be underlined. m) the names and contact details of at least three experts, from outside "Mihai Viteazul" National Intelligence Academy, working in the same thematic field, who have accepted to write recommendation letters of the applicant's professional qualities (only for proffessor and associate professor) and their letters of recommendation; n) Other documents required by the human resources department.
