Minimum weekly teaching load: 8 conventional hours, of which at least 4 conventional hours are devoted to teaching activities.  By way of exception, where, due to the specific nature of the courses, the curriculum does not include lectures, the minimum weekly teaching load is increased by two conventional hours.  Research load (applied research in support of intelligence education), as applicable, in accordance with Article 211 paragraphs (18) and (19) of Law No. 199/2023.  Full teaching load (including teaching, research and academic service): 40 hours per week.  Appointment to this position requires advanced, field-specific knowledge, as well as professional competences and skills corresponding to the advertised disciplines, and implies compliance with the eligibility conditions for the academic career advancement examination laid down in Article 8 paragraph (3) and Article 12 paragraph (2) of the <b>Methodology governing internal academic career advancement procedures at the “Mihai Viteazul” National Intelligence Academy.</b>  In carrying out teaching and learning activities, the academic staff member cooperates with colleagues from the Department of Security Studies and Leadership, as well as with academic staff from the other departments of the Faculty of Intelligence Studies, in line with the principles of collegial substitution and the interdisciplinarity criteria underpinning the delivery of specialized education. <b>Exam procedure</b>	File evaluation and delivering a lecture in accordance with the adopted methodology (art. 21, 22).
<b>List of documents</b>	<p>The application dossier shall contain the following documents:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>a) the application form for admission to the examination (Annex No. 5), signed by the candidate, which includes an affidavit assuming responsibility for the accuracy of the information provided in the dossier (Annex No. 8);</li><li>b) a proposal for the candidate's academic career development, both in terms of teaching and of research activities; the proposal is drafted by the candidate, shall not exceed 10 pages and is one of the main criteria used to differentiate between candidates;</li><li>c) the candidate's curriculum vitae, in hard copy and electronic format, in the Europass model;</li><li>d) the candidate's list of publications, in hard copy and electronic format (Annex No. 6);</li><li>e) the ANIMV standards compliance form, using the standard format laid down in the institutional methodology; the form is completed and signed by the candidate (Annex No. 1);</li><li>f) documents attesting the award of the doctoral degree: a certified copy of the doctoral diploma and, where the original doctoral diploma is not recognised in Romania, a certified copy of the recognition or equivalence certificate;</li><li>g) a synopsis of the PhD thesis in Romanian and in an international language, of no more than one page in each language;</li><li>h) an affidavit by which the candidate indicates any incompatibility situations provided for in Law No. 199/2023 on higher education that would apply in the event of passing the examination, or confirms the absence of such situations (Annex No. 7);</li><li>i) evidence of having obtained the performance rating "very good" in each of the last 3 years;</li><li>j) an affidavit by which the candidate confirms that he/she has not been subject to disciplinary sanctions in the last 3 years;</li><li>k) copies of any other diplomas attesting the candidate's studies;</li><li>l) a copy of the identity card or, where the candidate does not hold an identity card, a copy of the passport or of another identity document issued for a purpose equivalent to that of the identity card or passport;</li><li>m) where the candidate has changed his/her name, copies of documents attesting the change of name, namely the marriage certificate or proof of the name change;</li><li>n) up to 10 publications, patents or other works by the candidate, in electronic format, selected by the candidate and considered to be the most relevant for</li></ul>
